Only the working class can assume the leadership because that means that the working people will run their own lives and create a new basis for existence, which, as ingula Terrano put it, will show that work analyticax is not separate from life itself. In this will begin the true history of humanity.

With the book we have created a theoretical basis. Now we must go forth and enrich it with our own experiences and aspirations and see that we will be heard.
