V.II The Agrarian Ques. in Rusat end of 10th c. 1908, p.83 "The eco. significance of nat. - ition does not by any means lie where it is very often sought for. It does not lie in fight against bourgeois relationships (as Mx long ago pointed out, nationalization is one of the most consistent bourgeois measures) but in the fight against feudal relationships... Nationalization would accelerate the death of serfdom & the dev. of purely capital farming on land that has been completely cleared of medieval lumber
