Dear Olga:

Please thank Richard, and tell him that these are 2/3rds of 2nd chapter; and the final third will be sent to him next week.

Let him or whoever in the local with him will be doing the work to please make 6 copies and, outside of keeping 1 copy for himself, to send them all to us, and we will send from here to locals, and I need to keep one for myself and one for Europe.

Please, also, maintain the double spacing as single spacing makes it too difficult to correct, and there will be plenty of corrections after I finish the tour. Also, to mark clearly that ~~it is~~ it is a rough draft.

It may be easier to leave the footnotes at the end; however this must mean only the end of each section, since I started anew in each section. I may even have left some footnotes out; I seem to remember a #14 in the 2nd section which I couldn't make up my mind on since it meant listing so many manuscripts by Marx I'd need a page just for it. So, if there is no 14, still to maintain that number blank instead of renumbering which would mean that I will forget to put one in when it really matters, in the final draft.

O, by the way, he should be sending out a little note to Johnny and Luc & invite them at least for the theoretical conference in handwritten form; I assume any notices that are sent for public meetings they get notices automatically.
