Dear Richard,

Here are the galley proofs for Part II. You will note that I'm introducing a serious transposition in the Chapter V on Mao. It is clearly marked on the galleys, but permit me, also, to spell it out here:

1) After the quotations at the top of galley 69, the chapter should begin with the section on ~~Discontinuities and Continuities~~, which becomes section A. (galley 70). I would, however, like the subhead (1) **THE SINO-SOVIET CONFLICT** to stand out as an important heading, set on a line by itself, with the paragraph beginning on a new line.

The transposed section then follows in sequence through galleys 77, 78, 79 up to the end of that section, where I have deleted half a paragraph.

Immediately following "rootless teen-agers" return to galley 69, where the paragraph "Grasp the revolution" will follow the paragraph ending "rootless teen-agers." At the end of this paragraph, I wish to transpose the subhead *From Contradiction to Contradiction to Contradiction* (which becomes B) and the italicized quote from galley 70. Then continue with galley 69 through 72.

2) At the top of galley 73, I wish to add a new subhead -- C. Alienation and Revolution -- which is followed by a single short paragraph. Then add a new head (1) *Hong Kong Interview* -- after which the copy continues, as is, through 73, 74, 75, and the top of 76.

3) Here we conclude with the section on Sheng Wu-lien (galley 79) except that this heading is now changed to be (2) and reset in all-caps-type. The galleys then continue in sequence through to the end of the chapter on galley 84.
