CH. I. LENIN: THE RISE & FALL OF THE SECOND INT.

2nd Int. - July 1889 in Paris -- result of German SB & followers of Guesde
1891, Brussels & (1892 ERFURT PROGRAM)

1893, Zurich -- disturbance from anarchists who substitute general strike for pol. action

1896 - London -- anarchists expelled

1900 - Paris, ISB est. with headquarters at Brussels,
published his challenge; and Millerand entered ministry.
KAUTSKY & BEBEL introduce Centrist Res. considering that a
tactical, not a principled ques., passes 29-9 over Guesde's
demand for unconditional condemnation of ministerialism.

strengthening of Right wing & centrists in 2nd Int. EXCEPT

1901 - Stuttgart, 4 amendments endorsed by
RL, Martov, Lenin to Bebel's Resolution on
militarism passed (128-108, with 10 abst.)

1910 congress at Copenhagen (Lenin defeated on
significance of int'labor movement of rising
opp. to militarism.) (Bud approved RL's motion
on use of general strike

1912 - Basle

1914 -- Collapse

Geneva section of Bolsheviks on Lenin's Thesis, Letter of Karpinsky
to VIL, 9/27/14: "Int. is undergoing a difficult crisis, i.e.
has suffered an ideol-pol. collapse, if you like, but
ON ONE QUESTION ONLY, the military ques...."

"So far no one, anywhere, or at any time,
has declared the "fatherland to be in danger" to that extent...." (147)

1915: Reply of LT to letter of CC on call for Conf:

Furthermore, under no condition can I agree with
your opinion, which is emphasized by a res. that Russia's defeat would
be a 'lesser evil'. This opinion represent a funda-
mental connivance with the pol. methodology of social
patriotism... (-p. 170)

(what is necessary is a) "rallying of
all int'lists REGARDLESS of their group affiliation
or of the TINGE of their int'lism.."(praises
Chkheidze's speech in Duma)

2/23/ 1915: Bukh's Thesis on Tasks & Tactics of Prol. (p. 187)

NB: Oct. 1916 begs L "not to force a split" (p. 217)

NB: 15 point platform: 10. The collapse is explained not
so much by the treason of the leaders as by the objective causes
of CHAUVINIST CONDUCT OF THE MASSES, by causes which have
their roots in the conditions of the prol. struggle in the
past epoch.

"11. These conditions by the very dev. of
cap society in an epoch of finance cap., in an epoch of wars &
internal shocks, are becoming matters of his."

L p. 223 speaks of "The scornful attitude
of imp. economism toward democracy..." & then

p. 225: "Imperialism is highly developed
cap. Imp. is progressive. Imp. is a
repudiation of democ; "hence", democ is impracticable under
cap." 14259

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SEP. 1918

p. 226: "Cap. in general, imp. in particular, transforms democ. into an illusion--and at the same time cap. generates democratic tendencies among the masses." // Rev. cannot be achieved without DEMOC. ORG. OF THEIR RANKS. "soc. cannot be realized except THROUGH the dic. of prol. which combines force against bourg--the min. of the pop.--and a COMPLETE deg. of democ.--of the ENTIRE mass of the pop. in all the STATE affairs & in all complicated afflux problems of liquidating cap."



GIVEN cap. society

civil war for soc. not only down of imp. war but CONNECTION bet. our struggle against war & struggle against opport nism/ b.w. against bourgeoisie is a war DEMOCRATICALLY org'd."

NBUKEARIN 12.1/1916 & THE IMP. PIRATE STATE

p. 236: "The state is an his. concept..." p. 237: "The power of arms & murder has thus become brazen law of the state, of every form of state without exception" p. 238: "The indiv. cap. has become an associated cap-ist a collective ownership by cap-iste.... So there comes into being a single, all-embracing org., the modern imp. pirate state, an omnipotent org. of bourgeois dominace, with innumerable functions..." p. 239: "The present war has shown how deeply the roots of STATEHOOD have penetrated into the souls of the wksr...."

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
