Aug. 1911 p.164 "Are you coming for the women's conference? Just imagine, I have become a feminist!" I received a credential for the conference and must therefore go to Jena. This was the year of the first International Women's Day on March 19, 1911.

On p. 202 RL writes about a testimonial for Clara from the women and she suggests books, whereupon they give her an artistic scroll. (May 29, 1917)
