Players Fail To Impress Staging "Romeo And Juliet"

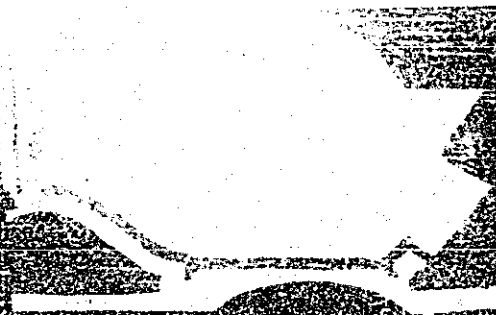
