I. To understand the events in Europe today we must go back to 1933when the rise of Her. fascism posed the question of world counter-revolution audinst the inherent world revolution.

We have since had fascism descend upon Europe and through the contralization of capital and destruction of workers organization challenge "old capitalism" for world power.
