Dear Colleagues:

So much of or This welcome to the new NEB includes, of course, all its members and not only those who have become NEB members for the first time. It is being written on the centenary of Marx's discovery of still newer moments of development in life and in thought, as he 1) read Morgan's Ancient Society: 2) visited Algeria and became aware of what we now call the Third World; and 3) projected the idea that "The Historical Tendency of Capitalist Accumulation" -- so characteristic of technologically developed Western capitalism -- need not be the only path for the so-called backward countries. On the contrary, concluded Marx, a backward country like Russia could achieve a revolution ahead of the West and thereby hew out still another path to "revolution in permanence."

I wish to develop this in the context of Hegel's Absolutes) on the one hand, and, on the other hand, new forces of revolution and Reason) for our age. Here are the three subheadings: I.
