I have had several scholars volunteer to search for it, but they were unsuccessful to find such an encyclopaedia and I do not recall precise name. I used to have many friends there—and recently also corresponded with Jofee's wife, but she is so tired—how she aver survived Stalin's labor camps I'll never know; when I heard she finally landed in Israel, it definitely sounded like some one reborn from the dead; and she sounded friendly and warm, but you could see why she wouldn't wish to correspond on anything political, so I dropped the whole matter-By now there is only one scholar I correspond with and I sent him the Rosa Luxemburg book because he was very interested and, as the author of what is the most scholarly biography of Trotsky who had referred to my views, I felt he should get it.
